

Vocational Nursing Program Application

Essay Guidelines

Purpose of Writing the Essay

Submitting an essay allows the applicant to demonstrate critical thinking; communicate his/her thoughts in a logical, organized manner; and apply principles of scholarly writing.

Evaluation Procedure

- The applicant will submit the completed essay as part of the application packet.
 Do not write your name on the essay. Write your name only on the cover page provided.
- 2. Two faculty (one nursing and one non-nursing) will review and comment on the essay. The scores are averaged, and one score awarded. The applicant name is then matched to the essay.

Writing the Essay

- 1. **Select only one (1) topic** from the three (3) provided below:
 - Integrity

What is integrity? Define in your own words and explain how it applies to the nursing profession. (Give an example of a situation in which, you or someone else showed integrity.)

- Professionalism
 - What is professional? Give an example of how you or someone acted professionally. (Describe the qualities of professionalism. Discuss how they apply to the nursing profession.)
- The Most Important Characteristic of a LVN

Identify which characteristic of a Licensed Vocational Nurse you believe is the <u>most important</u> to nursing. Discuss how that characteristic will affect your development as a Licensed Vocational Nurse and how you will practice vocational nursing.

2. Write the essay in your own words. Do not plagiarize.

<u>Plagiarism</u> occurs when you present someone else's work or ideas as your own, with or without their consent, by including it into your essay without giving the author credit. Copying material that someone else has written or copying and pasting online material is covered under this definition. This includes published and unpublished materials. If you have questions about plagiarism, please contact the Nursing Office. Plagiarized material will disqualify the applicant.

- 3. Follow the required structure for your essay.
 - Cover Page: place on top of your essay (see last page)
 - Must be typewritten. Type title on first page of essay. Do not type your name on the essay.
 - Use one-inch margins for all sides.
 - Double space; Times Roman font, 12 pitch
 - Maximum three (3) pages. (Cover page does not count as one page.)
