The District will review and recommend planning decisions through established committees with representation from faculty, administration, staff, and students. Those representatives make up the College Council/Strategic Planning and Steering Committee. Specific goals, objectives and strategies with measurable outcomes and specific accountability will be developed. Action plans will be reviewed and revised annually and approved through the collegial governance process.

The Board assists in developing the general institutional mission and goals for the comprehensive plans in various ways, including but not limited to, reviewing the District's action plans, curriculum items, and information items submitted for approval.
