Visitors on Campus

Palo Verde College is a community college; therefore, citizens of the District and others interested in visiting the campus shall be invited and encouraged to do so. It is virtually impossible to provide a guide for each visitor, but the Superintendent/President or designee shall attempt to provide whatever assistance and information is available to visitors.

The Superintendent/President or designee is assigned the authority for approval of off-campus individuals being invited to campus events as speakers/entertainers prior to invitations being extended by any student or staff organization, faculty or staff member.

The Superintendent/President or designee shall, at all times, be alert to protecting students and property from undesirable persons or behavior on campus.
