Programs:

Introduction to Building Trades Certificate of Career Preparation

The Introduction to Building Trades Certificate combines an overview of the building trades and construction industry. The combined coursework is intended to prepare students to enter the building trades with basic technical skills, a clear understanding of jobsite safety and the soft skills required to advance their careers in the building trades. Students completing this certificate will be well positioned to gain entry level employment, in new and remodel construction.

Program Requirements:

Required Courses (Total 12 units)- Complete all of the following:

- BCT100 Introduction to Building Trades 3 units
- BCT101 Rough Carpentry 3 units
- BCT110 Blueprint Reading 3 units

Required courses (Total 3 units) -Complete the following number of units: 3 units

- BCT205 Equipment Operations 3 units
- BCT102 Advanced Framing Techniques 3 units

Program Student Learning Outcomes:

Analyze construction safety concepts and demonstrate best practices related to construction job sites and equipment operations.

Fundamentals of Construction Certificate of Career Preparation

The Fundamentals of Construction Certificate Program addresses common skills necessary in the construction trades. This includes coursework focusing on maintaining and servicing residential electrical systems as well as plumbing. This certificate program explores construction techniques that involve assembling projects from many different arrays of materials from brick to concrete.
