These new Physical Education courses consist of both Lab Activity courses and Theory courses. Students may take the lab courses up to four times for credit. The theory courses are available for both face-to-face and distance education. PHE 110 is now a repeatable course.

The question was raised as to whether these new courses should use the old numbers in order to keep numbers available for future use. It was decided to assign new numbers for these new courses and either delete the courses in the current catalog or move them to inactive.

PHE 112, 136, 142, 144, 152, 154 and 156 to be taught in Distance Education format. All members in favor; motion carried.
