Often Identified By Their Behavior

Some Factors to Watch For

- *Nervousness
- *Staring
- *Inappropriate language/prayer
- *Repeated entrances in/out of buildings
- *Keeping Hands in Pockets
- *Hanging Around After Hours

Most Important Thing Is To Be Observant

Three Important Things

- 1)Do Nothing
- 2)Investigate & decide whether to take emergency steps
- 3) Emergency steps immediately

This is a decision only you can make in light of circumstances/ personal comfort level & safety considerations

If you choose to in to investigate, greet the person in a friendly fashion. Evasive or unusual questions or answers may trigger your response. Excuse yourself and initiate your procedures/ code word (EDNA-Emergency Developing Need Assistance) with colleagues.

Make sure Dispatcher understands nature of call.
