Phlebotomy Program Entry Requirements

Admission to the Palo Verde College Phlebotomy Program requires that students meet all college admission requirements and the following:

- 1. Provide an official high school completion transcript or an official graduation equivalency exam (GED) transcript.
- 2. Provide documentation of three college-level biology courses.
- 3. If applicable, submit a non-U.S. transcript evaluation confirming U.S. high-school equivalency.
- 4. Commit to the clinical training requirements, agreeing to complete all required clinical hours during the program's second semester.
- 5. Complete all clinical training provider requirements, including vaccinations, TB testing, and proof of malpractice insurance.
- 6. Follow the dress code/attire requirements of all clinical facilities where training will take place.
- 7. Successfully complete a background check and drug test through CastleBranch.

Important Notes:

- The application process for the Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT) license through the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) requires disclosure of any past felony convictions.
- Transportation to and from clinical sites is the student's responsibility and is required to complete the course.
